

American Girl Club

Mission: For moms and daughters to gain deep relationships with other Christian Homeschooling families through learning and playing. We take a common interest and apply learning, eating, and activities to achieve lasting friendships.

There are three groups of girls:

Younger Kindergarten to First
Middle Second to Third
Older Forth to Fifth

Middle school Helpers- Each middle school child will be assigned a group below that will be alternated each month. If there are specific areas the children want to help in, then we can discuss that too.

Prices:

The club is free, but each girl between the ages of K-5 will be charged \$40 for the entire year. The \$40 includes your snacks and activities for 6 months for each girl. You can acquire the books at your local library, borrow, or even purchase them.

Babies to 4 will be in childcare and that will be \$2 per child. This pays for snacks, replenishment of stocks for the church (such as wipes), and activities. You must provide bottles and diapers.

All middle school helpers will be free. Their time and involvement with their sisters is special and we would not charge for help ☺. This club is total family involvement, no one gets left out.

Boys Club (see below for description) is \$30 for an entire year per boy. This includes snacks and activities for 6 months for each boy.

Assembly- Pray over group, girls, and parents. We will be having a short devotion each month during this time. This is also the time that I will talk about any announcements.
Talk – Each group will start discussing the book that was assigned to the family for that month. This will have an open, friendly feel with some discussion questions to keep the girls focused on what we are discussing.

Snack- Snack will be also in groups. We will start with K/1 then go forward. The snacks will be time period appropriate.

Craft- This is the time of the day where the girls will be constructing a craft or participating in an activity that is appropriate for the time period of the girl we are studying.

Clean Up- All families must participate in cleaning, before they leave. The church has graciously invited us into their home and we need to clean it better than how we found it.

Pick Up – Once everyone has cleaned their area, meet back in sanctuary to pick up children.

Parent participation:

Every child must have a parent present in order to participate in American Girl Club. All parents will be assigned positions within the group. Without parent involvement, the club cannot exist. I will ask parents to tell me where they would care to be and make a schedule for the year.

Sick Day or Vacation:

Please let me know if you are going to be out that day. First, we can lift you up in prayer during Assembly. Second, so we know where to fill in other helpers. Everyone gets “honest” crudes so just let us know ☺. The morning of club day will be just fine for sickness, but for Vacation a month in advance would be great! You will not be able to make up the activity or craft for that month.

Refunds

Due to the bulk buying to purchase snacks and activities, American Girl Club can not give you a refund for the annual fee. This is a year commitment. Moving and family illness is completely understandable, just let us know.

Boys Club

This will be a secondary club for the brothers of American Girl Club members. This club is all about Legos. Boys Club is split up into two groups:

Club Jr	Kindergarten to Second
Club	Third to Fifth

Same rules apply here for the schedule, parent participation, etc.

Each boy will have assigned reading each month, just like the girls. Theirs will vary from month to month. Moms will get a list on the Informational Meeting. There are not specific books, but by topic. Their snack will be somewhere around the topic studying. Then they will construct a Lego masterpiece from their magazines. They will be able to take home the magazine. At the end of the year, we will have a “campout” with a movie (smores and popcorn!! Yum).
