Sellers:

- Sellers must register to receive a seller number by Monday, April 12, 2009. Email your name, address and phone number to Melanie McBride at melanie@jmxservices.com. Put "ENCHEA Book Sale" in the subject line of your email. If you are selling in GHEA AND ENCHEA, please add that info to your email. Melanie is assigning number for GHEA and has offered to let ENCHEA use the same number system to make things easier for those selling in both sales.
- Your labels will be emailed to you after you register. You must use these labels. When you receive the label document, print as many as you need, cut apart, fill out and tape to your items. Please use Scotch tape only and tape only two sides of the label (top & bottom OR right & left sides). Do not use packing tape and do not tape around all 4 sides of the label.
- Drop off your labeled items at the door of THE BASEMENT at Unity from 9:00 – 10:00a.m., April 15th. Items will not be accepted after 10:00a.m. Period. NO EXCEPTIONS. The door will be locked at 10:00 a.m. and re-open at 11:00 a.m. for the sale. Volunteers will place everything on the correct tables according to grade and subject.
- Pick up your unsold items from 2:00 – 2:45pm. If any of your items are left behind after the sale, including free items, your check will be held until you pick up your leftover items from Karmen Wade, karmenw@charter.net.
- Eagle's Nest will send you a check for the items that you sell within 10 business days from the day of the sale.
- Eagle's Nest will take the very best care of your items, however, we cannot be held responsible for missing items. By placing your items in the Eagle's Nest Used Book Sale, you have agreed that we are not responsible for missing items.
- Eagle's Nest will keep 5% of all sales.

Labeling and Pricing Information:

- EVERY ITEM must have completed ENCHEA label attached - even free items to avoid confusion.
- Price items in \$0.25 increments.
- Attach labels with scotch tape along two sides of the label so that the label can be removed without tearing or damaging the item.
- Please securely bundle your items by using multiple strong rubber bands or large zip-lock type bags.
- We pledge to take the very best care of your items the day of the sale. Please do your part in labeling correctly, securing items in a set, and securing loose parts.

Shoppers:

We will accept cash/change and checks. You may write one check for your purchases. All items will be taken to cashiers for purchase, and the cashier will remove the label, which will be sent to the seller with their earnings. DO NOT REMOVE THE LABEL.

Children:

Since ENCHEA is being entrusted with the use of this facility and sellers' items, we ask that you keep children with you and do not allow children to play in the building or with the items being sold.

What Can You Sell? –Anything related to homeschooling
